NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority is: Organising Authority: Circolo Surf Torbole with Federazione Italiana Vela & International iQFOiL Youth& Junior Class Association with the cooperation of The Foiling Week Organisation.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*
- 1.2. The National prescriptions that will apply will be posted on the Official Notice Board.
- 1.3. RRS Appendix B will apply, however RRS B5 61.1(a) and B8.A8 are deleted.
- 1.4. RRS Appendix T Arbitration will apply. Do you want this???
- 1.5. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available online at <u>Foiling week iQFOiL race – Circolo Surf Torbole</u> from the 27th of June 2023. No printed copy will be provided by the OA.

3. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

The online official noticeboard is located at the ground floor

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to IQ class boards and sailors U15,U17 and U19 sailors.
- 4.2 U19 age division shall be open to all competitors entered into this event, but only if that competitor is under 19 years of age on 31 December 2023 (born on 2005 or later).
- 4.3 U17 age division shall be open to all competitors entered into this event, but only if that competitor is under 17 years of age on 31 December 2023 (born on 2007 or later).
- 4.4 U15 age division shall be open to all competitors entered into this event, but only if that competitor is under 15 years of age on 31 December 2023 (born on 2009 or later). They will race with the U17 fleet. Events shall run concurrently.
- 4.5 Entries will be accepted by the first come, first served principle and payment is mandatory at the moment of entry. No entry can be completed without payment.
- 4.6 All board must comply with their own class rules
- 4.7 All competitors shall be members of their National Class Association or the International Class Association where there is no appropriate national class association.
- 4.8 The competitor named on the entry form shall be the same for all races.
- 4.9 All competitors/riders- may be required to wear a BIB, if required they will be provided by the Organizing Authority. All bibs must be worn whilst racing and on the outside of all clothing.
- 4.10 Eligible competitors shall enter by completing the online entry process at: https://www.circolosurftorbole.com/iscrizione-foiling-week-iq-foil-2023/
- 4.11 The entry fee costs 100 euro and includes the barbeque party with drink and music which will take place the 29th or 30th June (date to be confirmed) at the Fraglia Vela Malcesine.
- 4.12 Online entries will close on June 27th, 2023.

4.13 All documents related to the registrations (third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent and payment receipt) must be sent by email at <u>segreteria@circolosurftorbole.com</u> <u>by</u> <u>11.59 pm of the 27th of June 2023</u>, specifying the Class and Sail Number in title. The Italian competitors must also send the card of the Italian Sailing Federation (ordinaria plus) which includes the third-party liability insurance and medical certificate

5. FEES

5.1 The entry fee of Euro 100 must be paid by bank transfer or by STRIPE:

5.2 Cancellation policy: For entries cancelled before the 20th of June at 23.59 the entry fee paid will be refund 90%. For notifications after the 21st of June at 00.00 and before the regatta 50% of the entry fee paid will be refunded. After the 27th of June no entry fee will be refunded.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions will set out the schedule and format of racing. The exact format to be used will depend upon the level of entries, but will aim to follow the IQ Foil Class racing format for International events.
- 6.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal on the 29th of June 2023 is 13.00hrs.
- 6.3 The maximum number of races to be sailed for will be 10 (5 per day).
- 6.4 There will be no warning signal made after 17.00hrs on the 30th of June. Prizegiving will take place as soon as possible after the last race for each class.
- 6.5 A schedule of social events will be posted with the Sailing Instructions.

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate for all equipment and sails at registration if requested.
- 7.2 Other class measurement requirements will be set out in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.3 Equipment shall only be replaced with the permission of the Race Committee.
- 7.4 Boards may be subject to inspections at any time during the regatta.

8. VENUE

The event will be held at Circolo Surf Torbole, Torbole, Lago di Garda.

9. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

The penalty system to be used will be displayed on the first day of racing on the official notice board.

11. SCORING

The scoring system to be used will be set out in the Sailing Instructions but will follow The IQ Foil class guidelines.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered at the race office of Circolo Surf Torbole. Private motorboats are not permitted on this section of the lake without the "temporary permission" granted through the host club. This permission is free. The drivers shall show the following documents:

- 1. Navigation license for motors with 40.8 or more; otherwise, identity card or passport.
- 2. Boat insurance.

with the permission each coach will receive an identification sticker to stick on the boat and a flag. For the flag the club will ask a deposit of 30,00 euro. Please send in advance the documents of the boat and the filled permission (attached) per mail at: segreteria@circolosurftorbole.com. It's forbidden to moor the boats in the harbor close to the club.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A competitor shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14. PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three or more competitors Male and female in both the U17 and U19 events.
- 15.2 Additional prizes may be given at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

15. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- 16.1 By participating in Foiling Week 2023, competitors automatically grant the Organizing Authority and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 16.2 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.
- 16.3 The top three (3) competitors, as well as the individual race winners, may be required to attend a media press conference each day.
- 16.4 Competitors may be required to be interviewed during the regatta.

16. LIABILITY

As per RRS.3, the regatta participants take part in the regatta under their full and sole responsibility, the Competitors and their support persons are the only responsible for the decision to take part or to continue the race; the Organizers decline any and all liability for damages that may occur to persons and / or things, both ashore and offshore, as a result of their attendance at the regatta covered by this Form; it is competitors task and their support people task to decide according to their abilities, the wind, the sea conditions, the weather forecasts and everything else should be forecasted by a good sailor, whether to go offshore and take part the regatta, to continue it or to quit it.

17. SUSTAINABLE EVENT

Foiling Week is a World Sailing Special Event Sustainability Charter signatory. The event will uphold and report against the 10-point Charter to align and support the objectives of Worlds Sailing's Sustainability Agenda 2030.
